Subject: FLOOD ADVISORY (for 02nd – 04th April, 2026)

Dear Sir,

I am directed to enclose herewith the Alert no. A-03/2026 dated 02nd April, 2026 received from Chief Meteorologist FFD, Lahore on the subject noted above, wherein it is intimated that according to the latest Hydro – Meteorological and Meteorological Conditions, **River Kabul at Nowshera** is expected to attain **High Flood Level** and **flash flooding** is also anticipated in all its tributaries during the period.

Furthermore, **flash flooding** is also expected in the **Kohat Toi, Kurram, and Gomal rivers**, as well as their associated tributaries.

It is therefore requested to kindly take all precautionary measures to avoid any loss of life, damage to infrastructure/ crops, and animals. Furthermore, all concerned authorities may be requested to take the following safety measures:

- a) Identification of vulnerable points / at-risk communities and devising mitigation and safety measures.
- b) Maintain enhanced alert level/monitoring of the developing situation to reduce reaction/response times.
- c) Rescue 1122 & Civil Defence to remain alert and ensure availability of personnel and equipment during the forecast period, especially in at-risk areas.
- d) People living along the banks of the River Kabul, Kohat Toi, Kurram, and Gomal, and their associated Nullahs to be sensitized about expected flash flooding/ increase of water flows.
- e) Timely evacuation of at-risk population from low-lying / flood-prone areas as per Evacuation Plans and availability of shelter, food, and medicines in those shelter camps.
- f) Locals/farmers/ cattle herders be forewarned to shift cattle away from low-lying areas adjacent to the River Kabul and its associated Nullahs.
- g) Restrict vehicle movement in low-lying / at-risk areas, close to the River Kabul and its associated water channels/nullahs.
- h) Provision of relief / medical supplies to affectees on time.
- i) Coordinate with concerned departments for clearance of roads in case of any blockage/obstruction, waterlogging, and pre-placing of necessary emergency equipment at vulnerable/appropriate locations.
- j) In case of any occurrence, updates may kindly be shared with PEOC, PDMA on 6th hours basis
- k) PEOC, PDMA is active round the clock via toll helpline 1700 for any guidance and help

FLOOD WARNING

(for April 02nd – 04th, 2026)

According to the analysis of latest Hydro-Meteorological and Meteorological Conditions, River Kabul at Nowshera is expected to attain **High Flood Level** and flash flooding is also anticipated in all of its associated tributaries during the period.

Flash flooding is also expected in the nullahs of central and northern Balochistan (Zhub, Nari, Beji, Shirin & Bolan Rivers and associated tributaries), DG Khan Division (DG Khan and Rajanpur districts Hill Torrents) as well as in the Kohat Toi, Kurram & Gomal rivers and their associated tributaries.


Additionally, nullahs in Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir are also likely to experience flash flooding.

Concerned authorities are advised to remain vigilant and take necessary precautionary measures. Residents of vulnerable and low-lying areas, particularly those near streams and nullahs, should remain vigilant and avoid unnecessary movement during the forecast period.
